The Janki Saye Foundation was founded in 2015 by sisters Sheila and Mala as a legacy to their mother Janki.

The aim of this charity is to provide grants to fund assistive technology for people with complex disabilities and special needs.

Assistive technology communication and reading devices can transform lives by bridging the gap between limitation and liberation.

Communication devices provide a voice to people with disabilities which impact speech and motor skills. They empower individuals to express themselves and communicate their thoughts, wants and needs to those around them.

Whether it's a child saying "I love you" for the first time, a stroke survivor telling you their story, or someone simply ordering a coffee on their own – these are the moments that make them feel less isolated and more connected.

Reading (text to speech) devices help enhance independence and improve the quality of lives of people with visual impairments.

For someone who's blind or visually impaired, access to information isn't a luxury – it's a lifeline. Whether it's reading a book, navigating a menu, or sending a message, every interaction with text is a potential barrier.. or a bridge.

Over the last 10 years we have awarded grants to 76 very deserving beneficiaries. We have helped individuals living with conditions which have included motor neurone disease, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, stoke, traumatic brain injury, sight loss and neurodivergence.

We are a small charity which is run entirely by volunteers and we rely on the generosity of donors and supporters. With very minimal operating costs, we are able to ensure that all monies raised go towards funding grants.
